POINT SCALE

CONTRIBUTIONS:

4 = Routinely provided useful ideas when participating in the group discussion. A definite leader who contributed a lot of effort.

3 = Usually provided useful ideas when participating in the group discussion. A strong group member who tried hard!

2 = Sometimes provided useful ideas when participating in the group discussion. A satisfactory group member who did what was required.

1 = Rarely provided useful ideas when participating in the group discussion. Sometimes refused to participate.

QUALITY OF WORK:

4 = Provided work of the highest quality.

3 = Provided high quality work.

2 = Provided work that occasionally needed to be checked/redone by other group members to ensure quality.

1 = Provided work that usually needed to be checked/redone by others to ensure quality.

ATTITUDE:

4 = Never was publicly critical of the project or the work of others. Always had a positive attitude about the task(s).

3 = Rare was publicly critical of the project or the work of others. Often had a positive attitude about the task(s).

2 = Occasionally was publicly critical of the project or the work of other members of the group. Usually had a positive attitude about the task(s).

1 = Often was publicly critical of the project or the work of other members of the group. Seldom had a positive attitude about the task(s).

FOCUS ON THE TASK:

4 = Consistently stayed focused on the task and what needed to be done. Very self-directed.

3 = Focused on the task and what needed to be done most of the time. Other group members counted on this person.

2 = Focused on the task and what needed to be done some of the time. Other group members had to sometimes nag, prod, and remind to keep this person on task.

1 = Rarely focused on the task and what needed to be done. Let others do the work.

WORKING WITH OTHERS:

4 = Almost always listened to, shared with, and supported the efforts of others. Tried to keep people working well together.

3 = Usually listened to, shared with, and supported the efforts of others. Did not cause "waves" in the group.

2 = Often listened to, shared with, and supported the efforts of others, but sometimes was not a good team member.

1 = Rarely listened to, shared with, and supported the efforts of others. Often was not a good team player.
