The OSRT's commitment to student professional growth and development is demonstrated through the OSRT Student Director Program. This program is open to OSRT student members in their first year of a primary imaging or therapy program. One student will be selected as a board member from April 2025 to April 2026. The selected student will also attend the OSRT Leadership Academy in June 2025.


